1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

The flash rate of the LED beacons is 30 per minute. The beacons flash synchronized to one another. The sidelights burn steady.

A by-pass switch (SW1) allows the controller to be turned on during daylight hours without covering the photocell. This is particularly helpful since the controller can be mounted indoors while the photocell is outdoors.

The photocell is the three (3) blade, twist to lock, type.

Power supplied to the controller shall be 120/240V, three (3) wire, single phase.

2.0 INSTALLATION

2.1 <u>MOUNTING THE CONTROL CABINET</u> (Refer to Drawing 1309-R)

- 2.1.1 The power supply control cabinet can be located at the base of the structure, or in an equipment building. Mounting footprints are shown on Drawing 1309-R. Power wiring to the control cabinet should be in accordance with local methods and the National Electrical Codes (NEC).
- 2.1.2 If the control cabinet is mounted inside an equipment building, the photocell should be mounted vertically on ¹/₂" conduit outside the building above the eaves facing north. Wiring from the photocell socket to the control cabinet should consist of one (1) each: red, black, and white wire. The white wire is connected to the socket terminal marked "Li," and the red wire is connected to the socket terminal marked "Lo." As above, the photocell should be positioned so that it does not "see" ambient light, which would prevent it from switching to the nightmode.
- 2.1.3 If the control cabinet is mounted outside an equipment building, the photocell should be mounted vertically on $\frac{1}{2}$ " conduit so the photocell is above the control cabinet. Care must be taken to assure that the photocell does not "see" any ambient light, which would prevent it from switching into the nightmode. The photocell wiring is the same as in 2.1.2.

2.2 PHOTOCELL INSTALLATION

(Refer to Drawing 1309-R)

- 2.2.1 The wiring from the photocell, the service breaker, the red LED beacons, and the sidelights should enter the control cabinet through water-tight connectors in the bottom of the cabinet. Inside the cabinet, the connections will be made on terminal blocks and circuit breakers located at the bottom of the chassis. These connections are made as follows:
 - a) Connect the **<u>BLACK</u>** wire from the photocell to the terminal block TB2 marked "L2."



- b) Connect the **<u>RED</u>** wire from the photocell to the terminal block TB2 marked "SSR."
- c) Connect the <u>WHITE</u> wire from the photocell to the terminal block TB2 marked "N."

2.3 **POWER WIRING**

(Refer to Drawing 1309-R)

- 2.3.1 Power wiring to the control cabinet should be in accordance with local methods and the NEC.
- 2.3.2 Circuit breaker needs to be rated a two (2) pole common trip rated at 10 amps.
- 2.3.3 Connect incoming 120V AC "Hot #1" to terminal block TB1, marked "L1."
- 2.3.4 Connect incoming 120V AC "Hot #2" to terminal block TB1, marked "L2."
- 2.3.5 Connect neutral wire(s) to one (1) of the terminal blocks on TB1, marked "N."
- 2.3.6 Connect the AC ground to the grounding lug located to the left of TB2.

2.4 <u>**RED BEACON AND SIDELIGHT WIRING**</u> (Refer to Drawing 1309-R)

- 2.4.1 Connect the **FIRST** wire from LED Beacon #1 to the Circuit Breaker marked "B1."
- 2.4.2 Connect the **SECOND** wire from LED Beacon #2 to the Circuit Breaker marked "B2."
- 2.4.3 Connect the **THIRD** wire from LED Beacon #3 to the Circuit Breaker marked"B3."
- 2.4.4 Connect the **FOURTH** wire from LED Beacon #4 to the Circuit Breaker marked "B4."



- 2.4.5 Connect the **FIFTH** wire from LED Beacon #5 to the Circuit Breaker marked "B5."
- 2.4.6 Connect the **<u>SIXTH</u>** wire from LED Beacon #6 to the Circuit Breaker marked "B6."
- 2.4.7 Connect the **FIRST** wire from LED sidelight group #1 to the Circuit Breaker marked "S1."
- 2.4.8 Connect the <u>SECOND</u> wire from LED sidelight group #2 to the Circuit Breaker marked "S2."
- 2.4.9 Connect the **<u>THIRD</u>** wire from LED sidelight group #3 to the Circuit Breaker marked "S3."
- 2.4.10 Connect the <u>NEUTRAL</u> wire(s) to one (1) of the terminals on TB1, marked "N."

3.0 THEORY OF OPERATION

3.1 <u>POWER SUPPLY</u>

120/240V AC enters the controller from the Circuit Breaker panel. Lines "L1" and "L2" sit at the PRD, waiting to be switched. When the 6390-FAA photocell is activated, line "SSR" energizes the coil of the PRD. This also can be accomplished by using the photocell by-pass switch (SW1).

3.2 <u>LED SIDELIGHTS</u>

Line LDS is sent to the Circuit Breakers marked "S1,""S2," and "S3," which power the LED sidelight circuits.

3.3 <u>LED BEACONS</u>

Line LDB is sent to the coil of the motorized flasher and the six (6) sets of contacts on the 30S8 motorized flasher. When the controller is turned on, these contacts will deliver the voltage to Circuit Breakers "B1 – B6," which will operate the LED Beacons at 30 flashes per minute.

4.0 MAINTENANCE

4.1 <u>RED OBSTRUCTION LIGHTING</u>

No scheduled maintenance is required. Perform on an "as needed" basis only.

TOOLS REQUIRED: NONE

4.2 <u>L-864 LED BEACON REPLACEMENT</u>

No scheduled maintenance is required. Perform on an "as needed" basis only.

4.3 <u>L-864 CONTROLLER</u>

No scheduled maintenance is required. Perform on an "as needed" basis only.

4.4 **PHOTOCELL**

The photocell is a sealed unit. No maintenance is needed or required, other than replacement as necessary.

TWR Lighting®, **Inc.** ("**TWR®**") **warrants its "LED Product"** against defects in design, material and workmanship for a period of five (5) years from the date of shipment. TWR[®], at its sole option, will, itself, or through others, repair, replace or refund the purchase price paid for "LED Product" that TWR[®] verifies as being inoperable due to original design, material, or workmanship. All warranty replacement "LED Product" is warranted only for the remainder of the original warranty of the "LED Product" replaced. Replacement "LED Product" will be equivalent in function, but not necessarily identical, to the replaced "LED Product."

TWR Lighting[®], **Inc.** ("**TWR**[®]") **warrants its "LED Product"** against light degradation for a period of five (5) years from the date of installation. TWR[®], at its sole option, will, itself, or through others, repair, replace, or refund the purchase price paid for "LED Product" that TWR[®] verifies as failing to meet 75% of the minimum intensity requirements as defined in the FAA Advisory Circular 150/5345-43G dated 09/26/12. All warranty replacement "LED Product" is warranted only for the remainder of the original warranty of the "LED Product" replaced. Replacement "LED Product" will be equivalent in function, but not necessarily identical, to the replaced "LED Product."

Replacement parts (other than "LED Product") are warranted for 90 days from the date of shipment.

- x The site name and number
- x The part number(s)
- x The serial number(s) (if any)
- x A description of the problem
- x The billing information
- x The Ship To address

This RMA number must be clearly visible on the outside of the box. If the RMA number is not clearly labeled on the outside of the box, your shipment will be refused. Please ensure the material you are returning is packaged carefully. The warranty is null and void if the product(s) are damaged in the return shipment.

All RMAs must be received by TWR LIGHTING[®], INC., 10810 W. LITTLE YORK RD., #130, HOUSTON, TX 77041-4051, within 30 days of issuance.

Upon full compliance with the Return Terms, TWR[®] will replace, repair and return, or credit product(s) returned by the customer. It is TWR[®]'s sole discretion to determine the disposition of the returned item(s).

<u>Replacements</u> – Replacement part(s) will be shipped and billed to the customer for product(s) considered as Warranty, pending return of defective product(s). When available, a certified reconditioned part is shipped as warranty replacement with a Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) number attached. Upon receipt of returned product(s), inspection, testing, and evaluation will be performed to determine the cause of defect. The customer is then notified of the determination of the testing.

- x Product(s) that is deemed defective and/or unrepairable and covered under warranty a credit will be issued to the customer's account.
- x Product(s) found to have no defect will be subject to a **\$75.00 per hour testing charge (1 hour minimum), which will be invoiced to the customer.** At this time the customer may decide to have the tested part(s) returned and is responsible for the return charges.
- x Product(s) under warranty, which the customer does not wish returned, the customer will be issued a credit against the replacement invoice.

<u>Repair & Return</u> – A Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) will be issued for all part(s) returned to TWR[®] for repair. Upon receipt of returned product(s), inspection, testing, and evaluation will be performed to determine the cause of defect. The customer is then notified of the determination of the testing. If the returned part(s) is deemed unrepairable, or the returned part(s) is found to have no defect, the customer will be subject to a **\$75.00 per hour testing charge (1 hour minimum), which will be invoiced to the customer.** Should the returned parts be determined to be repairable, a written estimated cost of repair will be sent to the customer for their written approval prior to any work being performed. In order to have the tested part(s) repaired and/or returned, the customer must issue a purchase order and is responsible for the return shipping charges.

<u>**Return to Stock**</u> – Any order that is returned to TWR[®] for part(s) ordered incorrectly by the customer, or unneeded upon receipt, the customer is required to pay a **20% restocking fee**. A credit will be issued once it is determined that the Return Terms are met.

<u>Credits</u> – Credits are issued once it is determined that all of the Warranty and Return Terms are met. All credits are processed on Fridays. In the event a Friday falls on a Holiday, the credit will be issued on the following Friday.

<u>Freight</u> – All warranty replacement part(s) will be shipped via ground delivery and paid for by TWR[®]. Delivery other than ground is the responsibility of the customer.
